While not all inclusive, our membership includes the local American Legion posts, Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW), American Veterans (AMVETS), Military Officers Association of America (MOAA), Military Order of World Wars (MOWW) Disabled American Veterans (DAV), Desoto Marine Corps League, Goodwill Manasota, Turning Points, Merchant Marines, Multiple Auxiliaries, American Legion Riders, American Legion Sons, University of South Florida Sarasota/Manatee (USFSM), State College of Florida Veterans Association, Manasota Elks, Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR), Jewish Family and Children's Services and the list goes on... We help articulate and champion our Veterans' needs with our government officials at all levels, Veteran Organizations, Veteran friendly businesses and provide an efficient direct benefits referral process. We even connect with our youth through our Flag and Patriotism Program.

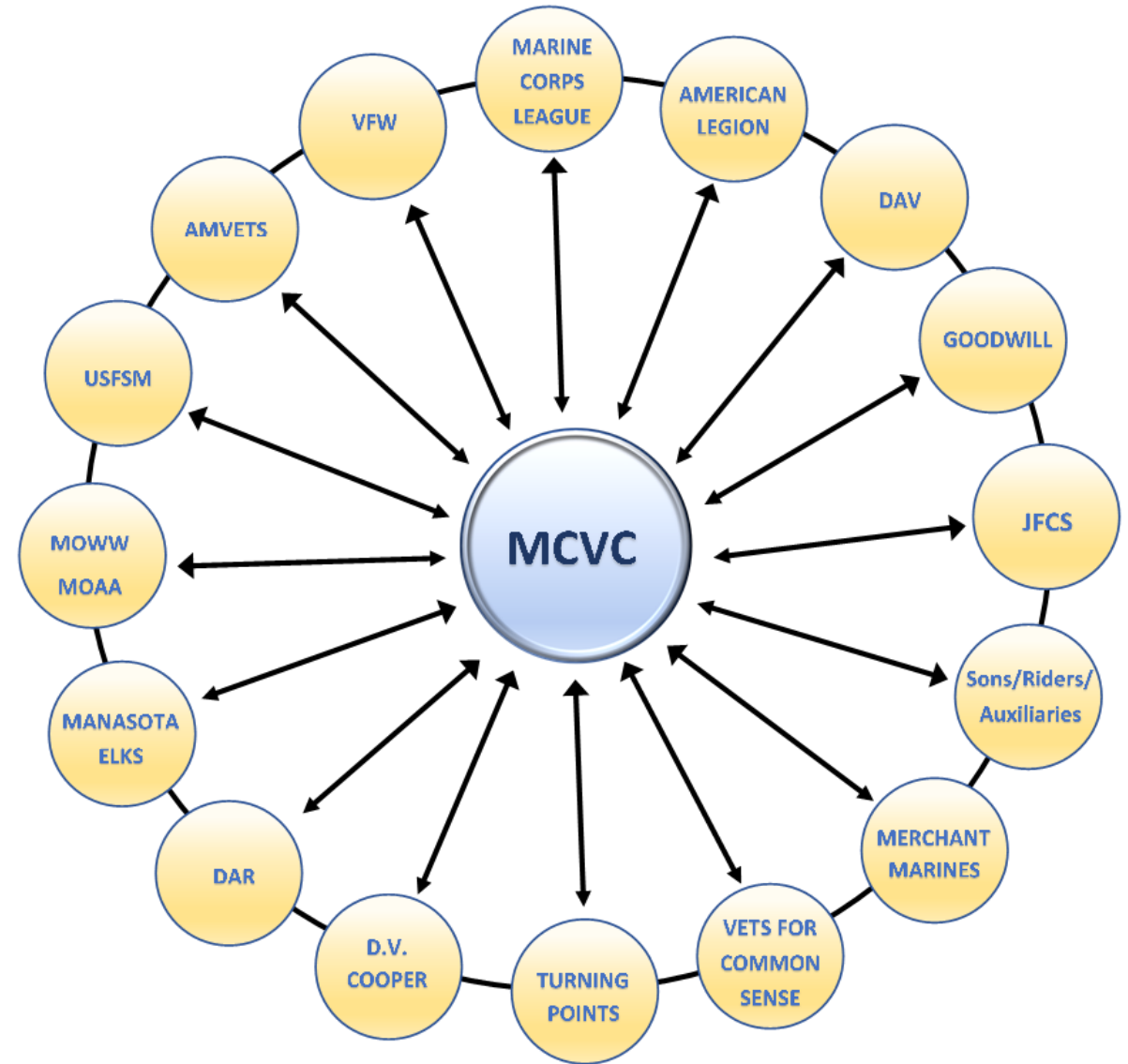
